This role will be multifaceted and we are looking for a can-do, get stuck in attitude!

The role will include advocating and promoting our programme in local health, education, social and voluntary sector spaces to enable ongoing recruitment of new participants to our programmes. What will you do if you get the job?

Line management:

- Support the Contract Manager in the organisation and delivery of Team Meeting
- Conduct monthly 1-1's with all nutritionists in the Gloucestershire team
- Support the recruitment and onboarding of new nutritionists into the Gloucestershire team
- Support the Contract Manager in the organisation of staffing rota for the delivery of programmes
- Work with the Contract Manager to quality assure the delivery of BZ Families, providing constructive feedback

Programme Delivery:

- Be part of a team that delivers BZ behaviour change and weight management programme
- Empower individuals to manage their weight and behaviour effectively by understanding their individual context and needs and supporting them to change behaviours
- Following up with individuals after sessions to ensure they are on track and referring onto alternative services if necessary
- Deliver a minimum of 1 BZ Families session in Gloucestershire
- Be available/able to cover any of the BZ Families sites running in Gloucestershire
- Be responsible for facilitating the organisation of nutritionist cover for sickness/holiday

Programme Development:

- Help to refine existing programmes and develop new ones in line with evidence, co-production and sound underpinning theories
- Regularly meet with Senior Nutritionists across other contracts to improve the delivery and content of the BZ Families Programme
- Ensure we deliver evidence based advice, keeping up with changes and new ways of working
- Support the recruitment of individuals to the interventions
- Liaise the engagement officer to create and deliver a recruitment and engagement strategy for BZ Families
- Liaise with marketing for timetables, flyers, leaflets and all other promotional collateral related to BZ Families
